As you know one of our staff members is a teenager who works a couple hours a week looking at anonymised data for us, and produced some very interesting data which I talked about last weekend. This has also been given to the NEDs who have found it equally interesting. I know as Founder and Director that when I set up the TMW it was to support young people and military Veterans who seem to struggle to get support when they need it. I also chose TMW to be a cic, and this is imperative as not everyone can afford to access our services without some serious financial support. We have survived in a challenging financial climate over the past 3

years, which seems to be the obligatory treading water time before we can start applying for funding, but which will prove challenging whilst I remain the sole Director. The NEDs will undoubtedly have a challenging meeting ahead of them in helping steer the future of TMW cic to ensure it continues as I first set it up with a vision in mind.
